#### **Tuskegee Airmen**

The Tuskegee Airmen were the first Black military aviators in the U.S. Army Air Corps (AAC), a precursor of the U.S. Air Force. Trained at the Tuskegee Army Air Field in Alabama, they flew more than 15,000 individual sorties in Europe and North Africa during World War II. Their impressive performance earned them more than 150 Distinguished Flying Crosses, and helped encourage the eventual integration of the U.S. armed forces. Learn more here.

#### **CCT Masking Policy**

### Preserving the Health of the Congregation During Worship

It appears that the respiratory illness season has already gotten underway in the New England area. Consequently, the Board of Deacons would like to remind everyone that the following measures may help to prevent the spread of infections of any type amongst the attendees at Sunday worship:

- 1) The wearing of good quality masks is effective in preventing the spread of illness from one to another, perhaps in preventing the acquisition of disease. The wearing of masks at worship will continue to be voluntary and participants are welcome to wear masks at any time.
- 2) Close contact with another can result in spread of disease so shaking hands or other direct contact should be avoided. As always careful handwashing or use of hand sanitizers is effective in preventing the spread of and acquisition of disease.
- 3) One should not attend in person worship if one feels ill in any way. Please utilize the Zoom app or watch worship on Community TV which is broadcast live. (Comcast Channel 8 or Verizon Channel 45 (http://www.boxfordcabletv.com). The Zoom link goes out to members in a separate email every Saturday with a "Link To..." subject.
- 4) Vaccination, with the latest version of COVID-19 vaccines, influenza vaccines, and possibly even the RSV vaccine, remains the best way to prevent serious consequences of any of those diseases. We encourage everyone to keep current with these vaccinations.
